

When we first met the Noodles team, they were in a tight spot.

In just a couple of months, their existing ERP would officially be considered end-of-life (EOL) and their solutions provider was forcing migration to a different on-prem system.

Urgently the team searched for a way out.

- They needed to integrate with their existing technology stack.
- This had to happen *fast*.
- And it needed to be in German.

Despite what the name might suggest, Noodles is a furniture company. They've been specializing in iconic steel designs and have been transforming commercial and residential spaces since 1990.

With success came complexity. Now, orders flood in from their showrooms and website, customized and configured across every conceivable dimension, requiring meticulous attention to ensure every piece arrives at a customer's door exactly as envisioned.

In a way, they needed an ERP vendor that operated like they did. Craftsmanship, rigorous customer service, a commitment to quality. And a bit of style.






Import Thousands of Rows, Instantly

3PL Data Sync

Prior to moving to DossARP, the Noodles team had to manually copy-paste shipment and inventory data from their 3PL via an FTP folder. Now, data syncs **automatically**.



Made-to-Order in DossARP

One majority piece of complexity was the need to make custom orders.

Noodles uses a **Configure-Price-Quote (CPQ) module** to streamline custom order processing without bloating the product catalog.


Lookups and filters are used to pull data from the catalog and differentiate between custom configurations and standard dimensions.

The options shown are tailored specifically to the context of the selections, ensuring payment methods, sizes, and locations are all considered.

Best of all, this CPQ module isn't *hard-coded*. Changing business process with DossARP is as simple as editing the flowchart.

No custom code or consultants required to revise your own processes.
